EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY MANDATORY SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

The Town has moved to single stream recycling, which means the following items are placed in a single receptacle:

- ~newspapers/magazines
- ~tin
- ~plastic (#1-7 only no exceptions)
- ~glass
- ~aluminum (cans only)

Recycling Acceptable –vs- Not Acceptable:

~newspapers/magazines

Acceptable: newspaper, magazines, junk mail, soft cover books, cereal boxes

Not Acceptable: wax paper, milk cartons, juice boxes, wrapping paper, corrugated cardboard

~tin

Acceptable: soup and tin cans

Not Acceptable: any biohazards (needles, etc.)

~plastic (#1-7 only-no exceptions)

Acceptable: plastics numbered 1-7 only

Not Acceptable: ridged plastic such as 5 gallon buckets, children's toys, trash buckets

~glass

Acceptable: all clear, brown, green, blue glass

food and beverage containers

Not Acceptable: fluorescent bulbs, mirror,

windowpane glass

~aluminum

Acceptable: aluminum cans only

Not Acceptable: trays, cookware, muffin tins

THE FOLLOWING SHOULD CONTINUE TO BE PLACED IN THE DESIGNATED AREAS AS DIRECTED BY SIGNAGE AND/OR TRANSFER STATION ATTENDANTS:

- ~corrugated cardboard (must be broken down)
- ~metal
- ~yard waste (compostable)
- ~brush (max. 6" diameter)

~metal pile

Acceptable: metal paint/gas cans, any metal container, lawn mowers, snow blowers, etc. All machinery must be drained of all fluids

~yard waste (compost pile)

Acceptable: leaves, grass clippings, hay, straw, horse manure, plants, anything compostable *Not Acceptable*: no plastic bags

~brush (max. 6" diameter) *Acceptable*: brush only

Not Acceptable: no brush over 6" diameter,

pressure treated wood, boards, etc.
