The Select Board announces its 2018 road plan. On April 9, 2018, the Board signed a contract with Pike Construction for road work at the Woodlands and Roberts Farm. As anticipated by the Board the contract is just under \$300k:\$298,082. We anticipate the work to begin the first week in June and be completed around the end of the month.

Work at the Woodlands is as follows: From Sligo Road to the cul-de-sac will be reclaimed then the remainder of the development will be shimmed and overlaid. Shoulder work will follow a few weeks later, probably in July.

Work on Heritage Drive is as follows: Approximately 400 feet will be reclaimed about 200 feet from Rollins Road as well as a section on Moses Carr. Both sections will be finished with a binder coat. The entire development will be shimmed and overlaid next summer pending town meeting approval.

It is advisable to allow the box cut/regrading at the beginning of Heritage Drive to rest a year before putting a final coat. In 2019 the Board expects to shim and overlay the entire development (Heritage Drive and Moses Carr Rd), completing the Roberts Farm road improvements.

The Board thanks Road Agent Guilmette for his able assistance in helping organize the contracted work. The Board will be working with Road Agent Guilmette to plan how best to use the remainder of the 2018 road maintenance budget once the Pike Construction final project costs are known.
