





To see if the Rollinsford School District will raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$5,870,582 (Five million, Eight Hundred Seventy Thousand, Five Hundred Eighty-Two Dollars).

Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$5,831,322 (Five million, Eight Hundred Thirty One Thousand, Three Hundred Twenty Two Dollars) which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Rollinsford School District or by law: or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with the RSA 40:13, X and XVI to take up the issue of the revised operating budget only.
